SUBJECT: County Jail Report – March 2009

Enclosed is the County Jail Inmate Report for March 2009. This report reflects the inmate population on March 5, 2009. This month, all of the functional county jails provided inmate information. The data in this report represents 100 percent of the county jails reporting and 100 percent of the State's population. Please note this report is a collaborative effort of both state and local agencies/departments, and the publication date is dependent upon a number of variables that are not within the direct control of the Department of Community Affairs. However, we make every effort to release the report as early as possible.

In March 2009, the number of inmates held in county jails *decreased* by 645 inmates to 39,434. The capacity remained the same, 42,214. The number of inmates awaiting trial *decreased* by 670 inmates to 23,625, and the number of sentenced inmates awaiting transfer to State Institutions *decreased* by 113 inmates to 5,188.





March 2009




□ Pretrial Inmates ■ Inmates Sentenced to State Institutions ■ County Sentenced Inmates ■ Other Inmates


Capacity of County Jails
January 1998 - March 2009




Jail Population
