

Specific Citation of Code Violations

Official Code of Georgia Annotated (O.C.G.A.)

Section 8-2-26 (f)

(Effective July 1, 2000)

“A local inspector, including a fire service employee enforcing a state or local fire safety standard, who specifies a code violation noted during an inspection shall, upon the written request of the permit holder, cite in writing the particular code book, section, and edition of the code which is the basis of the violation.”

- **Requires** local inspectors to cite with particularity the basis for violations of building codes when so requested by a permit holder.

Guidelines

1. Requires an inspector to cite in writing the particular code book, section and edition of the code on which the violation is based.
2. The inspector is required to do this only upon a written request by the permit holder.
3. The code section also applies to fire service employees enforcing state or local fire safety standards.
